Likely to roll forward and take catching while Noble Attack will be doing his best work late and has to be included.

Sticking with Targeted to make it two in a row after his easy win here last time. Form from that is good with both placegetters since winning and drops in weight with the class rise. Is in a rich vein of form and will be very hard to beat. Roth 'n' Bubble is very consistent and finished off hard over the shorter course last time. Should appreciate the 1250m if she gets some luck from the outside barrier. Ellie's Dream always has to be included in top fours and is never without a chance.

Fodor won this course two back before never settling over the 1400m at Townsville last time. Back to the 1250m with the small field will suit. He'll be in it for a long way. Spirit Meister is a big danger with the 3.5kg turnaround at the weights. Will likely stalk the leader and make him work for it. Tycoon Beau returned with a sneaky flashing run first up over the 1000m. Extra 250m here is in his favour and is a winner second up. Not ruling out Inching Closer who is a class horse in the race resuming after not a lot of luck in the carnival races.

Hard not to be impressed with the way Ellis Beach won his maiden at Townsville. Should press forward again here and looks suited to keep going on with it. Only concern is the drop back to 1250m. Ron's Finest Choice was slightly unlucky first up, being wide throughout but still finding the line. Only suited by the distance rise and inside barrier and will be the testing material. Thought Kickagoal Kenny could be worth an each way bet first up. Like him starting at the 1250m, should be on pace and in it for a long way while Tariff finished off well last time and should be included.

Thought Haphazard still had further improvement in him and was dropping back from the stronger 3yo grade last time. Drawn well with the inside barrier and can drive through and be hard to run down. Think Keepthewolvesaway should be kept very safe for his return. Has shown ability in his runs and will be better for having had another spell. Wired for Fun was good on debut at Innisfail and can keep going with that here.

Hard to go past Bloomin' Ripper who absolutely loves this track and distance. Form from her last run is very good and has had a slight freshen since then. Drops back from open grade to the benchmark 70 and just has to overcome the outside barrier. Hartshorn will prove hard to run down after winning 3 of his last 4. Gets in well with the claim and is well suited to this course. Ruby Chicks drops in weight from the last start win and before that wasn't far off Missile Thunder. Still improving and drawn to get a good run. Saturday Vibes will be much better suited second up and back on his home track and can't be ignored.

A very wide open race to finish things. Just thought it looked like a nice starting point for City of Boulder. They will go fast here and she should be able to just sit off the pace and produce a strong finish late. Catalina Dreaming will be further improved third up and dropping in class. Also aided by the 2kg claim and has drawn well to be in it a long way. Singular gets another chance after he was too bad to be true, doing a few things wrong last time. Back to the 950m is a plus. Interested to the see the FNQ debut of Khabalov. Looks like will be better suited over further but watch for any market support first up.
